# What Information do we need from you?

If you are applying for a permit where the construction works will be undertaken by LCC we will need the following information.	If you are applying for a permit where the construction works will be undertaken by a contractor of your choice we will need the following information

## Why do we need this?

We need this information to assess your application for a dropped kerb permit and also to arrange the works if necessary. We may also contact you to ask you to complete an evaluation to help us improve the service.

# Why are we allowed to process your information?

Data protection law allows us to process your information within certain conditions. In this case we are using the performance of a public task as the lawful condition for us to do this. No sensitive data will be processed as part of this service.

#### Who will we share this with?

Sometimes we need to share your information with others. We will only do this when it is necessary in order to offer you this service, or if we are required to do so by law.

When it is necessary, we may share your details with district/borough councils to discuss the vehicle access proposals where planning permission has been granted or is required for the new access, contact your nominated contractors to discuss the proposed dropped kerb works or disclose your personal information to specific contractors undertaking work on our behalf.

# How will we keep it secure?

We will take all reasonable steps to prevent the loss, misuse or alteration of your personal information. Only the people who need to see your personal information will be allowed access to it. We will not send your information outside of the UK. All data is stored securely with access only by authorised personnel.

## How long will we keep it for?

We will only keep this information for as long as necessary or as the law requires. For this service that would normally be kept for a period of 7 years due to business need to support investigations into highway status and extent, which is needed to support all statutory duties of the Highway Authority as defined by various legislation including but not limited to the Highways Act 1980.
