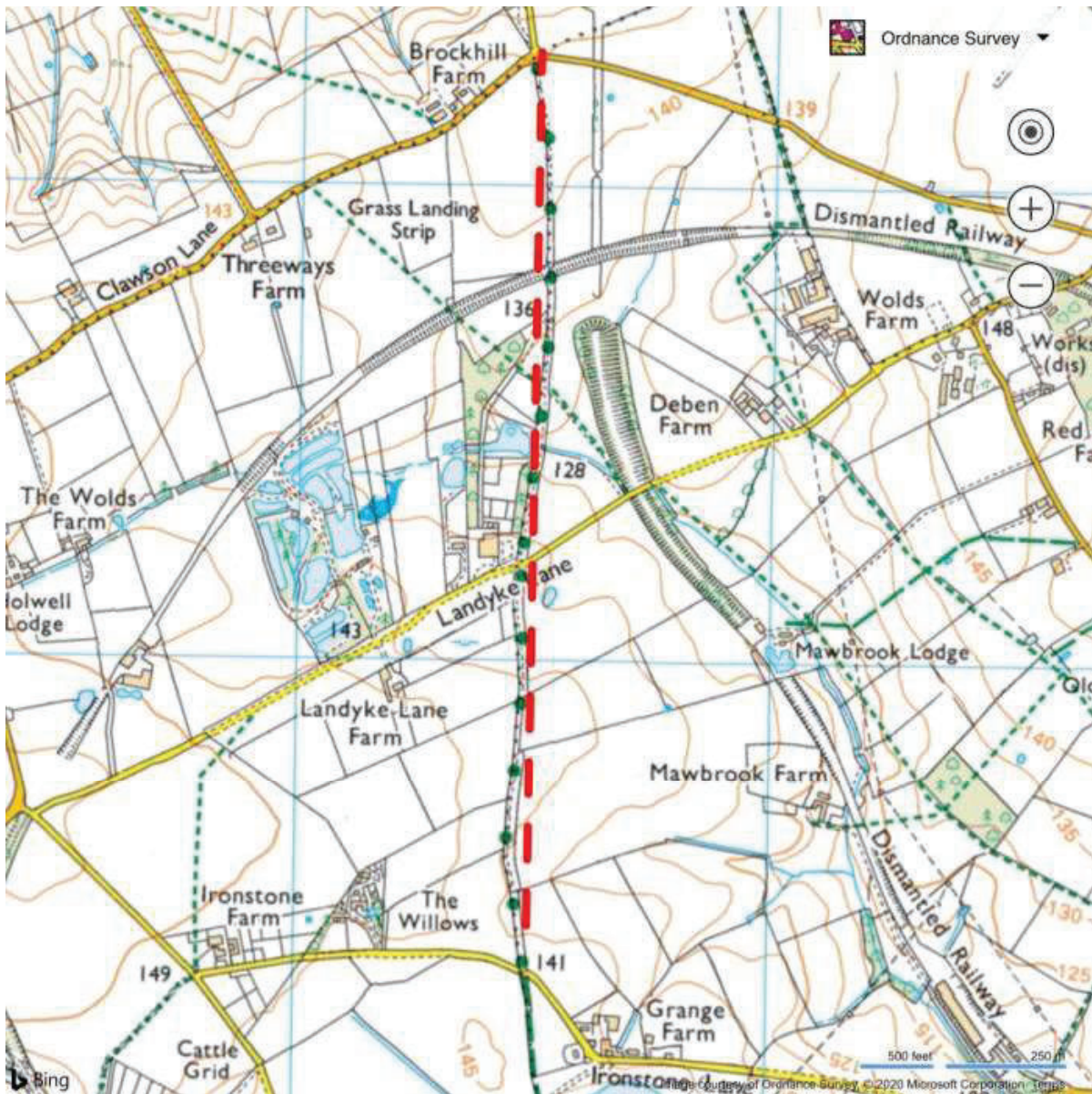

Map of Path: Route applied for is shown in RED DASHES between Ironstone Lane going directly north crossing Landyke Lane, continuing north to Clawson Lane close to Brockhill Farm. The route is shown as an ORPA on a track on OS Maps and is not on the online Definitive Map. The southern section is described on the list of streets as a footpath, whereas the northern section is only partially on list of streets.
