ACCESSING AND REQUESTING INFORMATION FOR PERSONAL SEARCHES

## **INTRODUCTION**

Leicestershire County Council together with the County's district and borough councils hold the majority of information required to respond to the Law Society's CON29 enquiries of local authorities. This information is required by those who complete property searches, both within local authorities and private search organisations.

The Environmental Information Regulations 2004 enable requests for this information to be made of local authorities. Leicestershire County Council therefore endeavours to publish as much of this information as possible, or make this information available through the most appropriate channels.

This document includes a schedule of information sources against each individual CON29 enquiry. Where information is not already published, advice on how this can be requested is shown.

The information sources included within this document may not be exhaustive. It is the responsibility of those who complete personal searches to use their own expertise and judgement in deciding which information sources are most appropriate for answering any given CON29 enquiry.

## **Enquiry 2.2, 2.3, 2.4, 2.5 – Public Rights of Way – Notes**

The County Council holds the Definitive Map for the administrative area. Please note that there are two parts to the statutory record of paths, the other being an accompanying statement.

Please note this is NOT the Definitive Map and is for guidance only. However, it does contain changes from Definitive Map Modification Orders published since the last paper map was produced. The line data is published in order to inform the public about where they can use paths and the status of the routes. It does not represent the legal entity that is the Definitive Map because of the limitations of the background mapping/aerial photographs upon which it is presented.

The Definitive Map for Leicestershire is continuously updated electronically to take account of legal events such as diversions, extinguishments, additions and deletions. This is done as part of the continuous review system introduced by Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1980). The last completed Review of the Definitive Map under the provisions of the National Parks & Access to the Countryside Act 1949 was in 1957.

At any one time there a number of Orders being processed that may or may not be confirmed at a future date, extinguishing, diverting or creating paths. On confirmation or the bringing into effect of a public path order, making a change to a public right of way, the County Council makes what is termed a 'Definitive Map Modification Order' (DMMO), which in turn provides the legal authority for it to alter the Definitive Map to take account of the change. Formal changes to the Definitive Map are then made digitally.

There are also full DMMOs that can create, delete or divert paths.
