

## **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

A prohibition of driving is being proposed to reduce the number of vehicles on the roads, to reduce the risk to pedestrians. Those that require access and deliveries will still be permitted to drive along the roads.

Given the nature and rural location of the lanes, including the narrow widths and high usage of pedestrians and vulnerable road users these locations are compatible with the proposed prohibition of motor vehicles except for access order.
