Steps:

1. Find a box big enough to sit in
2. If you have 2 boxes, you could copy your child's play. If they crawl in, you crawl in. When you copy them, you see the world from their point of view then they might copy you 😊
3. When inside the box, you can pretend you are in a car or a train by saying "car", "brum, brum" or "train", "choo, choo". Use actions to support what your saying. For example, pretend you have a steering wheel, or your arms are the wheels on a train
4. You can use toilet roll tubes as binoculars, glasses, a mobile phone or even the gear stick in the car!

- You can use pens or paints to create wheels on your car or buttons to press that make the windows go up and down



- You could find some cups and spoons and have a tea party in your box. Maybe you could turn it upside down and it can become a table. I'm sure the teddies would like to join in 😊
