

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Leicestershire County Council (LCC) is proposing to lower the speed limit from 30mph to 20mph on Macaulay Road and those roads leading off it including Shelly Drive, Byron Close, Tennyson Road, Dyson Close and Gale Close in Lutterworth.

Following concerns raised over speeds by residents, speed readings were taken and the speeds recorded were found to be conducive of a 20mph speed limit. Residents were consulted and were found to be in support of a lower speed limit, following this it is proposed to lower the speed limit to help reduce vehicle speeds and improve road safety in this residential area.

This scheme is being introduced on the grounds of road safety.
