


COVID-19: Data Update for Leicestershire

Period 28 July 2021 to 3 August 2021

Headline Summary

- 1. Trend in Weekly Incidence Rate (All ages) Leicester, Leicestershire, Rutland and England
- The national rate has increased from 282.3 (period 27th July to 2nd August) to 283.9 per 100,000 population (period 28th July to 3rd August). This latest rate reflects a percentage change decrease of 7% compared to the previous 7 day period for England.
- The Leicestershire rate has increased from 285.4 (period 27th July to 2nd August) to 300.1 per 100,000 population (period 28th July to 3rd August). This latest rate reflects a percentage change increase of 14% compared to the previous 7 day period for Leicestershire. The rate in Leicestershire is higher than the national average.
- The rate for Leicester City stands at 361.8 per 100,000 population and is above the national average. The rate for Rutland stands at 291.5 per 100,000 population and is above the national average.



2. Trend in Weekly Incidence Rate (all ages) – Leicestershire Districts

Blaby has the highest rate in the county (352.1 per 100,000, 359 cases), followed by H&B (346.6 per 100,000, 394 cases), NWL (305.3 per 100,000, 320 cases), O&W (296.6 per 100,000, 170 cases), Harborough (287.8 per 100,000, 275 cases), Charnwood (285.5 per 100,000 population, 538 cases) and Melton (163.4 per 100,000 population, 84 cases). Compared to the previous week, most districts (apart from Melton) have increased unlike nationally.





3. Trend in Weekly Incidence Rate (60+) – Leicestershire Districts

The data for 60+ population show the rate for Leicestershire is 66.5 per 100,000 population, lower than the national rate of 85.5 per 100,000 population. Blaby has the highest rate in the county (93.0 per 100,000 population, 25 cases) followed by H&B (86.6, 28 cases), Charnwood (65.3, 29 cases), NWL (58.2, 16 cases), O&W (57.3, 9 cases), Melton (51.3, 8 cases) and Harborough (40.5, 11 cases). Compared to the previous week, most districts (apart from Blaby, H&B and Melton) have decreased like nationally.
