THE LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL hereby gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under Sections 5 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, the effect of which will be:

1. To impose a 40 mph Speed Limit on parts of A60 Nottingham Road, Loughborough, Loughborough Road, Cotes and B676 Barrow Road, Cotes
2. To impose a 50 mph Speed Limit on parts of A60 Loughborough Road, Cotes and A60 Loughborough Road, Hoton

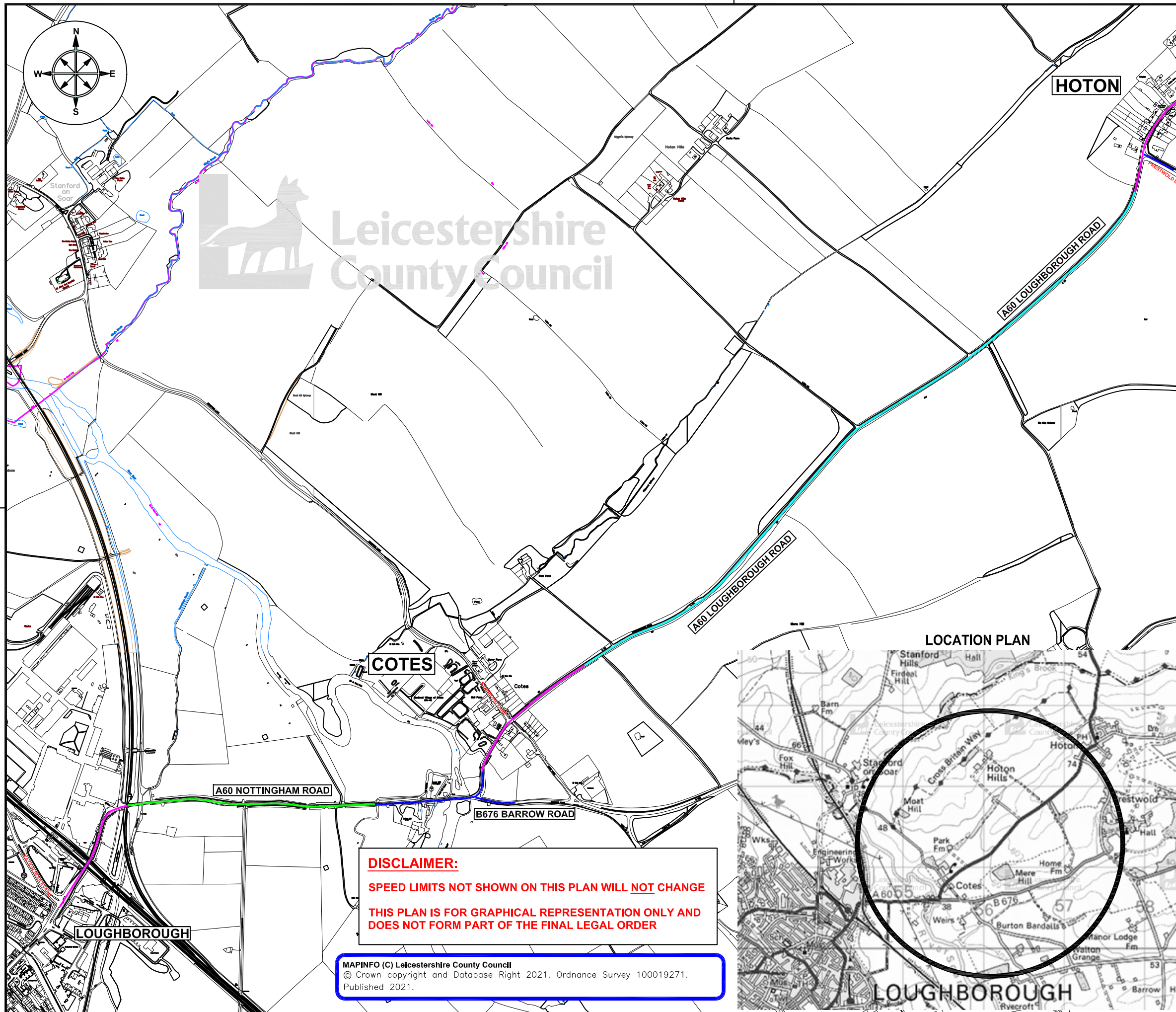

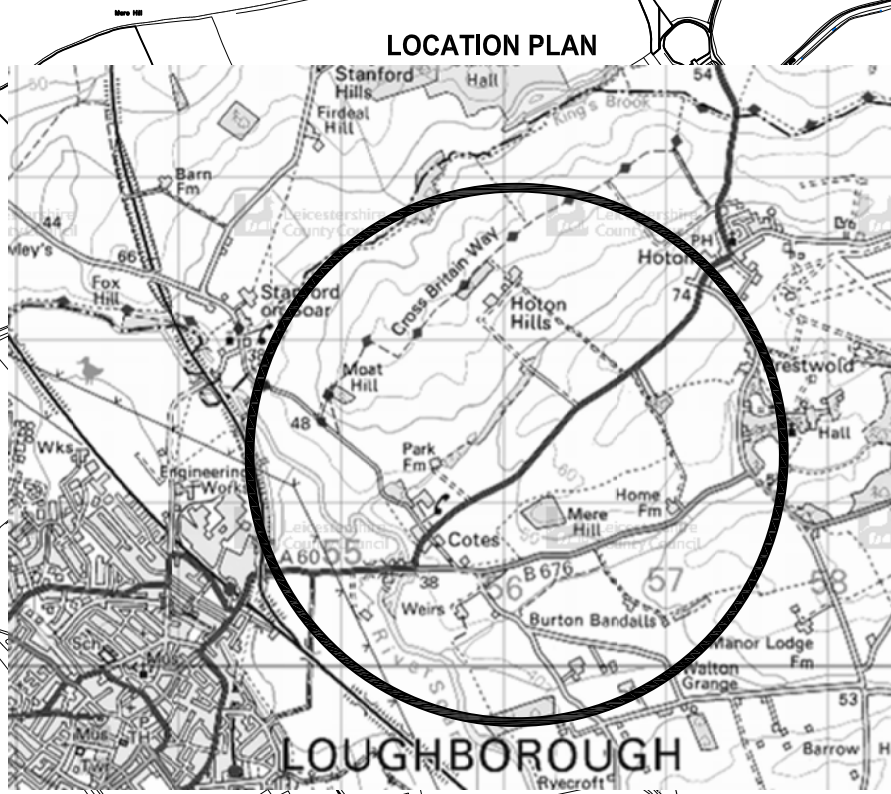

**STATEMENT OF REASONS**

All County roads that are assigned the national speed limit have been reviewed to identify those with an accident rate higher than the national average. As a result of this the A60, Loughborough, Cotes and Hoton has been identified to have a total number of accidents above the national average. Therefore, in order to increase general safety and reduce the accident rate, the County Council proposes to reduce the speed limits from 60mph to 50mph and 40mph.
