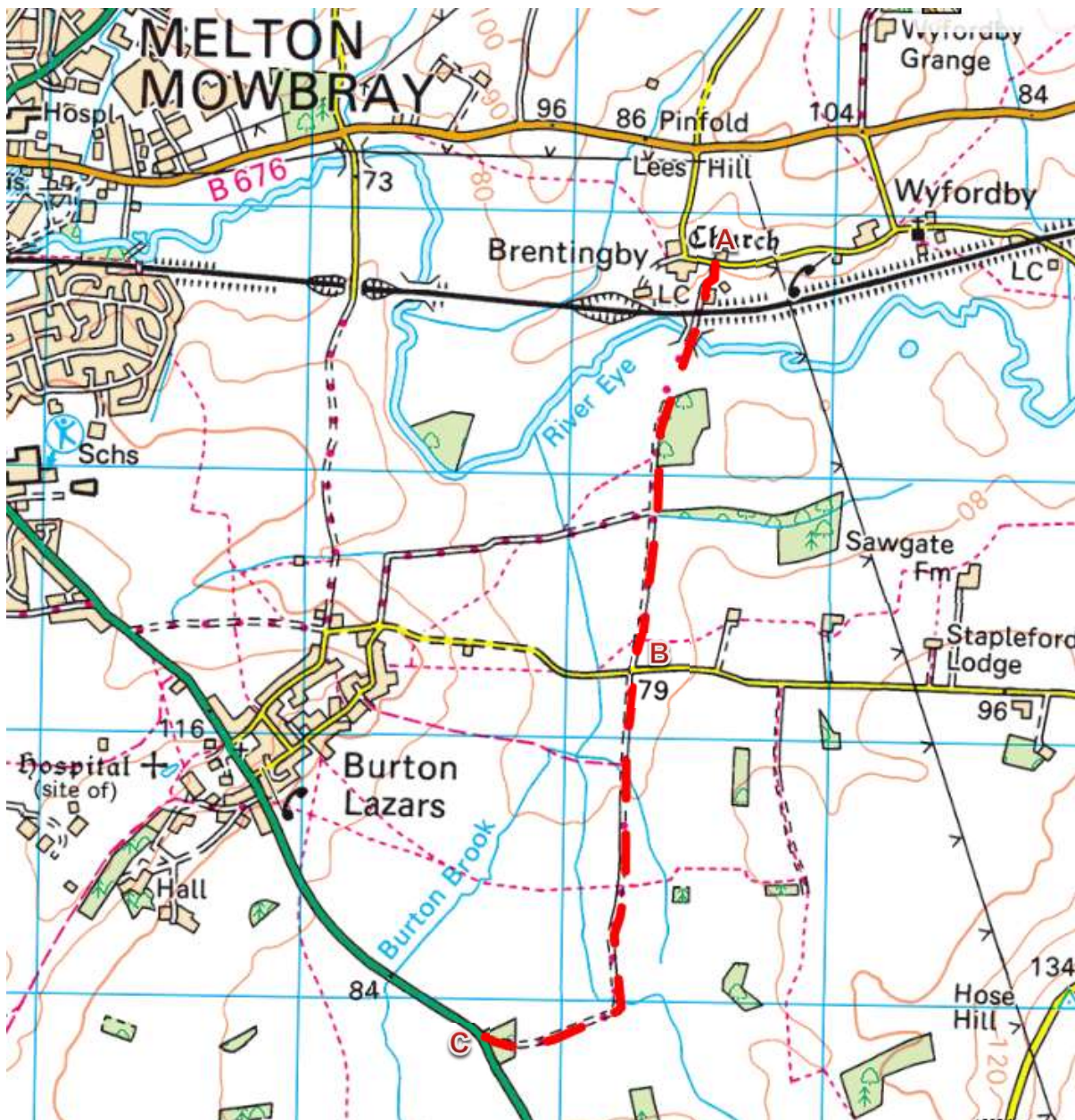
**Parish:** Burton & Dalby and Brentingby, Freeby **Grid Reference:** SK782173

**Map of Path:** Route applied for is shown in RED DASHES starts from the Main Road, Brentingby, Freeby goes south crossing the railway line and Sawgate Road before eventually turning west to end at the Melton Road, Burton Lazars on the A6060. The route is shown mostly as an ORPA on OS Maps and is mostly not on the online Definitive Map. There is however one section of footpath D105 crossing the railway. The application is for a BOAT, except for the upgrade of footpath D105 to a bridleway.
